Maths:

In rooms **S9** and **S10**, the staff from the Maths department will be displaying a variety of interactive resources as well as 'hands on' activities. English

In room **S2** year 10 are doing a Speaking & Listening Activity for their English GCSE. Each student will stand up and speak on a topic of their choice for about 3 minutes.

ICT:

In room **S14**, some of the ICT work done by Key Stage 3, will be demonstrated.

PSRE:

Staff will be in **S18** organising spot the differences, voting, match up and find it games. There will be prizes for everyone who has a go, so come along and join in!

In the Library:

There will be a "Guess Who Is Coming to Dinner" activity. You have to guess which book characters are expected to arrive.

LRC Learning Resource Centre:

Come along to see students demonstrating their cookery skills. They will be baking and decorating cookies. Staff will be there to explain the role of the **LRC** within the school as a whole.

Subjects and activities within the **Attwood** buildings:

Science :

The Science staff are based in rooms **A8, A9** and **A11**

There will be a range of continually running demonstrations and experiments, along with displays of students work in the rooms. The experiments will involve explosions, electric shocks, flame tests, and dissections.

If the weather is fine, some students will be outside with a teacher looking at the stars and planets with the departments' new telescopes. The new student built pond can also be visited.

Land and Environment:

There will be a display of photos showing how the students have worked on the land and the variety of food we have produced. A selection of tools will be available to view. Weather permitting, visits to a polytunnel and to the new sheds will be arranged.

There will be some end of our season produce on display.

Design and Technology

Design and Technology is to be found in the **Attwood building** and in the single story building beyond Attwood.

Rooms **A1** and **A2** are the Food Technology rooms, GCSE students and KS3 students will be working in both rooms with Mrs Barry and Miss Savage. In **A3**, students will be working on Textile projects, at both GCSE and A level with Mrs Brumpton. In the **DT suite**, Mrs Smith, Mr Morgan, Mr Shilvock and Mr Rowan will be offering Resistant Materials in **DT2** and Graphic Products in **DT5**.

DT1 is exclusively used for the teaching of A level Product Design and **DT3** houses 26 computers, offering CAD and CAD/CAM opportunities.

Academic Mentoring

Information about this will be situated in the **Dinning Hall in Attwood**.

This is a programme that runs throughout KS4 to raise the achievement of students studying for their GCSE's. Find out about our toolbox and how we make friends with exam papers. Come along and look at all the interesting things we get up to in our mentoring sessions.

Subjects and activities within the **Mall** buildings:

Humanities:
